Below is a list of suggested activities for GQMC Ambassadors. These ideas can support your outreach efforts. Be sure to document and submit your actions through your Ambassador account. You're also welcome to explore additional initiatives beyond this list.

Promote GQMC on Social Media

Help spread awareness by sharing official GQMC posts and information across platforms such as Facebook and Instagram. Tag the official pages to help increase visibility.

Add Your GQMC Ambassador Role to Profiles

Display your GQMC role proudly on your social and professional platforms like LinkedIn or Facebook. You can include a link to your ambassador profile.

Share GQMC with Friends and Classmates

Talk to peers in your school, university, or community about GQMC, explaining what the competition is and why it's exciting. Encourage them to participate.

Talk to Teachers and Coordinators

Introduce GQMC to teachers, club mentors, and school officials. Provide information about the educator platform and special awards for schools.

Present GQMC in Classes or Clubs

Give a brief presentation about the competition during a class session or club meeting to spark interest among students.

Distribute Posters and Flyers

Print and hang official GQMC posters at school, community centres, or libraries to attract attention. Digital copies can be found on the GQMC website.

Start a Quantum Mechanics Club or Group

Form a group at your school to explore quantum mechanics problems together, host problem-solving sessions, or use GQMC problems to build engagement.

Organise Quantum Mechanics Workshops or Events

Plan events like problem-solving workshops, physics discussions, or Q&A sessions where you introduce GQMC and quantum mechanics topics in an interactive way.

Create a Local Social Media Group

Establish a local WhatsApp or Facebook group for your school or city to coordinate GQMC efforts and share updates.

Collaborate with Local Organisations

Work with local science clubs, student societies, or institutions to promote GQMC or co-host events that highlight the importance of quantum mechanics.

Share GQMC through Newsletters or Blogs

Submit a short article about GQMC to your school's newsletter, student blog, or internal communication platforms.

Encourage Other Schools to Join

Extend outreach to other schools or universities in your area. Offer to share materials or connect them with the GQMC organising team.

Arrange Local Meetups

Organise informal meetups for interested students to discuss quantum mechanics topics and learn more about the competition together.

Support the Qualification Round at Your School

Coordinate with teachers to hold a scheduled Qualification Round session and assist participants in preparing and submitting their solutions.
